### Schwarze Unveils Latest Innovations at APWA Conference

On display at the show will be the newly redesigned A4000 street sweeper, the SP10 self-contained trailer spray patcher, and an A7000 sweeper mounted on Schwarze’s latest development, the 16T Cabover Chassis.

The result is a much more competitively priced chassis with the field support of a major chassis supplier, as well as the ability to adapt to the

various municipal fleet departments' specification requirements. Plus, it gives Schwarze Industries the ability to meet 2010 emission standards in a cabover configuration well ahead of our nearest competitors.”

The 16T Cabover Chassis can be used for the majority of Schwarze's larger machines, and Schwarze has already had numerous orders for the new chassis throughout the United States. “The 16T Cabover Chassis also allows for better visibility and line of sight for the driver,” said Massey. “As well as, a tighter turning radius than a conventional type chassis. Customers will also have the ability to add more water capacity for dust control.”



Schwarze will also be exhibiting in conjunction with another Alamo Group member, Vacall Industries.
